We are writing to share that on Monday, March 16, all Perspectives campuses will dismiss at 1:30pm.

It will be important for your student to come to school on Monday, as your student will receive important information about how to participate in e-Learning and log their e-Learning attendance. From 1:30pm-3:30pm, all Perspectives teachers will meet to ensure our e-learning plan, details attached, launches successfully for your student. Please know we understand this may create further disruption to your regular routine and we commit to providing safe aftercare from 1:30pm-3:20pm on Monday, March 16 only. From March 17-30, healthy meals will be available to our students. We recognize that our schools provide healthy meals to many of our students.
